Sub : Issuance of Permanent "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE"/Certificate of Recognition in favour of Santipur Public School, Babla Dakshinpara, Santipur, Nadia, Pin- 741404.

The State Level Committee constituted as per provisions of Rule 10 of West Bengal Right of Children to free & Compulsory Education Rules, 2012 in its meeting dated- 16/04/2018, had approved the proposal of issuance of 'No Objection Certificate'/Certificate of Recognition and hence the school education directorate hereby issues 'Permanent No Objection Certificate'/Certificate of Recognition for class I (One) to class VIII (Eight) in respect of Santipur Public School, as an unaided school, subject to observance of the following terms and conditions all the time failing which the 'Permanent No Objection Certificate'/Certificate of Recognition issued in favour of the school may be withdrawn.

1. That the school authority shall maintain and fulfil all the conditions all the time as mentioned in Rule 10(15) of the WB RTE Rules, 2012.
2. That the school authority shall never claim any financial assistance from State Govt.
3. That the school shall be located in a relatively noise free and pollution free area having adequate supply of drinking water and electricity.
4. That the school shall have classroom of adequate space commensurate with the enrolment which is comfortable and suitable for imparting lesson and not less than the number of class units.
5. That the school have a playground for the students and a barrier free access.
6. (a) That the school shall have separate toilet for the boys and girls (in case of co-ed school) and teachers.
6. (b) That the school shall have girls' common room, if it is a girls' or co-ed school, teachers room and adequate furniture.
7. That the school shall have sufficient fire safety equipments and have trained person/s among the staff to operate those equipments.

8. That the school shall not run for profit to any individual, group of individuals or any other person.
9. That the school authority shall implement the prescribed pay scales and allowances for the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.
10. That the school will pay its teaching and non-teaching staff emoluments at a rate which should not be less than those of their counterparts with equivalent educational qualifications in State-aided educational institutions.
11. That the school shall provide CPF (or any suitable PF) for employees as prescribed under relevant Provident Fund Act/Rules of Govt. of India.
12. That the school authority shall provide retirement benefits to the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school as per Death Cum Retirement Benefit Scheme.
13. That the recruitment of teacher shall be done in accordance with the NCTE norms and on merit in a transparent manner, to be laid down in the Memorandum of the Parent Body and information thereof shall be available to the State Govt., if necessary.
14. That the M.C. of the school shall be constituted with at least three guardian members, three elected teacher members and one non-teaching staff. The Principal will be an Ex-officio member of the committee.
15. That the school shall have students' admission procedure and fees structure duly published by the M.C.
16. That the school authority shall not enhance tuition fees or other charges without prior permission of the School Education Department. Govt. of W.B.
17. That the school shall not charge any capitation fee or equivalent to that by any means.
18. That the funds raised by the school authority, the fees collected and income earned by any other sources shall not be utilized for any other purposes than the welfare of the school and benefit of education of the students and teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.
19. That the school shall have to furnish accurate and up-to-date statistical information relating to the functioning of the school and its academic activities as and when the same is called for by the Deputy Director of School Education (AIS), W.B.
20. That the service condition of the teaching and non-teaching staff including provisions of security of service, disciplinary proceedings and procedure for Appeal shall be implemented in accordance with the directions laid down in the Memorandum of the Parent Body/ Management Committee and made available to the State Govt., if necessary.
21. That the school shall abide by procedure and rules and legal provisions that may be promulgated in this regard.
22. That the service of the teaching and non-teaching staff shall not be terminated without giving opportunity of being heard by the competent authority and without observing due disciplinary proceedings.
23. That the 10%(ten percent) of the new admission in the school in each academic year will be allowed on the recommendation of the School Education Directorate, W.B. and 50%(fifty percent) of such students will have to be allowed to prosecute studies in the school free of cost.
24. That the school conforms to, seeks to and has a curriculum to implement the values enshrined in the Constitution of India and promote respect for the National Anthem, National Flag, National Emblem and National Integration.

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25. That the school authority shall ensure that there shall not be any activity in the school which may create acrimonious feelings or division among students on the basis of caste, creed, race or religion.

Dear Sir / Madam,

In connection to above, I am directed to inform you that the Hon'ble President, WBBSE, in exercise of the power vested upon him u/s 28 (2) of the WBBSE Act, 1963, as amended, has been pleased to consider the report and recommendation of the State Govt. vide above mentioned memo **including reference nos : 1, 2 & 3** and to grant Up-gradation in favour of the above mentioned school with permission to open **Class IX from 01. 01. 2022 and Class X from 01. 01. 2023 provisionally for three years** subject to fulfillment of normal conditions enclosed. The school will send up its **FIRST BATCH of students at the Madhyamik Pariksha (Secondary Examination) in 2024.**

The terms and conditions as laid down in the above mentioned Memo are as follow :

1. That the School authority shall never claim any financial assistance from the State Government.
2. That the School authority shall implement the prescribed pay scales and allowances for the teaching and non-teaching staff.
3. That the School authority shall provide retirement benefits to the teaching and non-teaching staff of the School as per Death -Cum- Retirement Benefit Scheme.
4. That the Managing committee of the School shall be constituted with at least three guardian members, three elected teacher members and one non - teaching staff member.
5. That the School Authority shall not enhance tuition fees charges without prior permission of the competent authority.
6. That the School Authority shall not Charge any capitation fee or its equivalent by any means.
7. That the recruitment of teachers shall be done in accordance with transparent merit based criteria as laid down in the relevant Government Rules/ Government Orders and information thereof shall be made available to the State Government ,if necessary .

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8. That the funds raised by the School authority, the fees collected and income from any other source, shall not be utilized for other purposes than the welfare of the school and benefit of education of the students and the teaching and non-teaching staff of the School.

9. That any type of change in the ownership of the school or handing over of property or management of the school or changing /amending the character of the parent Body shall not be done without prior notice to the State Government.

10. That service of teaching and non-teaching staff shall not be terminated without giving opportunity of being heard by the competent Authority and without observing due disciplinary Proceedings.

11. That the service condition of the teaching and non-teaching staff including provisions of security of service, disciplinary proceedings and procedure for Appeal shall be guided by the directions laid down in the Government rules /Order.

12. Violation of all or any of the declarations as in Para Nos. 1 to 11 in this Affidavit shall constitute sufficient reason for withdrawal of N.O.C., or Up-gradation / affiliation, as the case may be.

13. The School shall abide by procedure and rules and legal provisions that may be promulgated in this regard.

The School is allowed to admit Class-VIII pass students of recognized 4-Class Junior High Schools or recognized High School on the basis of valid transfer certificate and should get those admitted students registered with the respective Regional Office in prescribed form with requisite fees within due date.

A report in the matter of fulfillment of conditions item-wise and seriatim attached to up-gradation should be forwarded to the Board positively within **six months**, with a copy to both The Director of School education, W.B. and District Inspector of Schools (SE) concerned.

The conditions attached to this Up-gradation as a High School are to be strictly complied with . In default, the Board reserves the right to cancel or withdraw recognition of the school.

The question of granting extension of the Up-gradation of the school will be considered on fulfillment of the conditions attached to this Up-gradation and submission of Final Fire NOC to the Board.

In view of this recognition as a High School the existing Managing Committee of the Jr. High School is allowed to function up to **31.10.2022** with the direction to Reconstitute the Managing Committee in accordance with the provision of the Management of Recognized Non-Government Institution (aided & unaided) Rules, 1969, as amended within **31.10.2022** The existing Administration / Ad-hoc Committee , if there be any has also been allowed to function up to **31.10.2022** by which time the reconstitution of the Managing Committee of the upgraded school must be completed according to Rules.

You are requested to acknowledge receipt of this letter and return the Enclosed Form No. 83 and St. 2 duly filled in by return of post positively. Henceforth the name as well as status of the school is hereby recorded in this office as : **SANTIPUR PUBLIC SCHOOL. [HIGH SCHOOL]**
